

Faktor-Faktor Pendorong Pendirian ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance on Disaster Management (AHA Centre)

Abstrak :

The ASEAN summit held on Vietnam, 2010, agreed that ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance on Disaster Management (AHA Centre) will operating in Indonesia at 2011. The establishment of AHA Centre is an implementation of ASEAN Agreement on Disaster Management and Emergency Response (AADMER), signed on 2005. The establishment of AHA Centre, 5 years after the AADMER signed is quite fast. Writer found 3 factors which encouraged the establishment of AHA Centre. There are (1) coordination models in the operationalization of AHA Centre was not contradictive with non-interference principle of ASEAN Countries, (2) the raise of awareness from ASEAN countries that maintain the disaster effect is a common responsibility, (3) the function of AHA Centre is effective for maintain the cooperation of ASEAN Countries in disaster management field.
